Below are the activities that are currently in the school diary for term 4.

20th February – TD Day – School closed to children.

22nd February - 9am - PSA Coffee Morning in the school hall. Come and meet our Parent Support Advisor, Dawn Mason. Parent Support Advisors are here to help families deal with issues, worries or concerns. She may not have the answer but will work with you to move forward. She offers free confidential support for parenting concerns, school attendance, establishing good routines, confidence building, relationship building, behaviour management, benefits/housing/debt, returning to work/education, school transition, healthy lifestyle, bereavement, bullying, mental well-being.

22nd February - Year 6 KS2 SATs and Secondary School Transition Information Session from 2.45pm to 3.15pm. Mrs Groves and Mrs Lamont. We aim to explain when the KS2 SATs take place, the subjects and skills assessed, the duration of the assessments, how we are preparing the children and ideas on how you can help. We also will discuss briefly how we prepare children for the transition to secondary school.

1st March - Parent Forum in the school hall -This is intended as an opportunity for parents to meet staff and governors and raise concerns or ideas with the school.

8th March - Hi5 Netball Match - For selected Y5/6 players.
